
### **Conference Site**

The conference will take place at the **Kriton Curi Salonu** within the **Albert Long Hall**. Albert Long Hall is located at **Boğaziçi University, South Campus** (in Turkish: **Boğaziçi Üniversitesi, Güney Kampüs**).

You need to show your ID at the entrance to the campus (please mention that you are attending the conference Advanced numerical methods for non-local problems).

Below you please find appropriate locations for booking a hotel (Levent, Taksim, and Old Town in the above metro map), and some alternatives for commuting to the university. We suggest installing the GoogleMaps and Moovit apps to your phones to see further alternative means of transportation.

### How to get to Boğaziçi Üniversitesi, Güney Kampüs from the airports

We suggest using the **METRO system** as the traffic in Istanbul is unpredictable. For this you need to purchase an **ISTANBULKART** from the **BILETMATIK**'s at the airports. While buying an **IstanbulKart**, you must pay a small non-refundable fee (for the actual card and the service), plus an amount of your choice to load onto the card. You can also load money onto the card later at the metro stations.

IstanbulKart can also be used on public buses (but not on HAVAIST or HAVABUS shuttles). Travel times listed below are only approximate.

## From ISTANBUL AIRPORT [ISTANBUL HAVALİMANI in Turkish] to BOĞAZIÇI ÜNİVERSİTESİ, GÜNEY KAMPÜS:

Both the Istanbul Airport and Boğaziçi Üniversitesi are on the European side of Istanbul. There are several options to get to the campus:

- 1) METRO (https://www.metro.istanbul/en/YolcuHizmetleri/AgHaritalari) + yellow TAXI: 1 hour
  - a. Take the metro line M11 (in the direction Kağıthane): Istanbul Havalimanı → Kağıthane
  - b. Take a yellow TAXI: Kağıthane → Boğaziçi Üniversitesi Güney Kampüs
- 2) METRO: 90 min
  - a. M11: Istanbul Havalimanı → Kağıthane
  - b. M7 (in the direction Yıldız): Kağıthane → Mecidiyeköy (2 stops)
  - c. **M2 (in the direction Haciosman):** Mecidiyeköy → Levent (2 stops)
  - d. M6 (in the direction Boğaziçi Üniv.): Levent → Boğaziçi Üniversitesi (3 stops)
  - e. As you exit the station, turn right and walk about 100m to find the entrance to the South Campus (Güney Kampüs).
- 3) HAVAIST (https://www.hava.ist/en/Home/Index )+ yellow TAXI: 2 hours
  - a. Take the HAVAIST shuttle to 4. Levent.
  - b. Take a yellow TAXI: 4. Levent → Boğaziçi Üniversitesi Güney Kampüs
- 4) HAVAİST (https://www.hava.ist/en/Home/Index )+ METRO: 2 hours
  - a. Take the HAVAIST shuttle to 4. Levent.
  - b. Take the metro line M2 (in the direction Yenikapı): 4. Levent  $\rightarrow$  Levent
  - c. Take the metro line M6 (in the direction Boğaziçi Üniversitesi): Levent → Boğaziçi Üniversitesi (3 stops)
  - d. As you exit the station, turn right and walk about 100m to find the entrance to the South Campus (Güney Kampüs).

# From SABIHA GÖKÇEN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SAW) [SABIHA GÖKÇEN HAVALİMANI in Turkish] to BOĞAZIÇI ÜNİVERSİTESİ, GÜNEY KAMPÜS:

This airport is on the Asian side while the university is on the European side.

- 1. METRO (https://www.metro.istanbul/en/YolcuHizmetleri/AgHaritalari): 100 min
  - a. M4 (in the direction Kadıköy): Sabiha Gökçen Airport → Ayrılık Çesmesi (21 stops)
  - b. Marmaray (in the direction Halkalı): Ayrılık Çesmesi → Yenikapı (3 stops)
  - c. **M2 (in the direction Hacrosman):** Yenikapı → Levent (8 Stops)
  - d. M6 (in the direction Boğaziçi Üniversitesi): Levent → Boğaziçi Üniversitesi (3 stops)
  - e. As you exit the station, turn right and walk about 100m to find the entrance to the South Campus (Güney Kampüs).
- 2. HAVABUS (https://www.havabus.com) + yellow TAXI: 90 min
  - a. Take the HAVABUS shuttle (in the direction Taksim) and get off at Kavacık: This takes 1+ hours. As you get off, you will be on an intercity highway.
  - b. Take a yellow TAXI: Kavacık → Boğaziçi Üniversitesi Güney Kampüs (You will go in the shuttle's direction and shortly pass across Bosphorus).
- 3. BUS + yellow TAXI: 2 hours
  - a. Take the bus number E3: Sabiha Gökçen Havalimanı → 4. Levent Metro (you will get off at the last stop; it takes about 2 hours).
  - b. Take a yellow TAXI: 4. Levent → Boğaziçi Üniversitesi Güney Kampüs

# Where to book a hotel and how to get to Boğaziçi Üniversitesi, Güney Kampüs

For ease of commuting, we suggest booking a hotel close to M2 metro line (which operates between Yenikapı and Hacıosman stations). At the Levent station (which should not be confused with the 4. Levent station) you can transfer from M2 metro line to M6 metro line which operates between Levent and Boğaziçi Üniversitesi/Hisarüstü stations.

The two regions close to the M2 metro line and populated with hotels are **Levent** and **Taksim**.

You may also want to stay in the old town (Aksaray/Sultan Ahmet region).

**Commuting from Levent region to Boğaziçi Üniversitesi:** If necessary take the M2 metro line and transfer to the M6 metro line at the Levent station; or else directly take the M6 metro line at the Levent station. The last stop is Boğaziçi Üniversitesi. As you exit the station, turn right and walk about 100m to find the entrance to the South Campus (Güney Kampüs).

Commuting from Taksim region to Boğaziçi Üniversitesi: Take the M2 metro line at the Taksim station (in the direction Haciosman) and transfer to M6 metroline at the Levent station. The last stop is Boğaziçi Üniversitesi. As you exit the station, turn right and walk about 100m to find the entrance to the South Campus (Güney Kampüs).

You may also prefer booking a hotel in the **old town (Aksaray/Sultan Ahmet region)**. In this case, perhaps the most practical means of transportation is to use the metro:

M1 (or M1A or M1B) (in the direction Yenikapı): Aksaray → Yenikapı

**M2**: Yenikapı → Levent

M6: Levent → Boğaziçi Üniversitesi

As you exit the station, turn right and walk about 100m to find the entrance to the South Campus (Güney Kampüs).
